<u>School update</u>

We return to school with a roll of 459 primary pupils split between 17 classes this session. We welcome Mr Jack Evans and Miss Becky Boyd to Uryside School as part of



their probationary year of teaching. Mr Evans is with P6/7 and Miss Boyd is with P2A. Both have settled in well and have two super mentors to support them over the year.

Miss Westwood has remained with us for 4 days a week, split between P2/1, P2A and P6/7. Miss Westwood made a very positive impact on the school last year so we are delighted to be able to retain her.

Miss Davidson will continue in her position as ASN teacher, supporting pupils and providing support to teachers and PSAs in meeting the needs of all. Unfortunately, with Government and Council cuts, we only have 4 days of support and therefore we are in the process of looking closely at how to support pupils in the best way possible within our resource constraints. With some careful planning, we have created additional time for Miss Davidson to be a full week with us which we are grateful for. We have an increase in our PSA time allocation to 169 hours a week. This may seem a lot but equates to 6 full time PSAs across the school. Again careful management of the time and resource is a priority to get the best for our pupils. For this reason, we have sought the assistance of parent volunteers this session and there is more information later on this.

<u>Lunches</u>


As you will be aware, we have had to resort to 3 sittings for pupils to have their lunch.

This is a slick operation to ensure all our pupils have a mix of playtime with friends and peers, but also have time to eat their lunch. Again, trying to prioritise and maximise the time our PSAs spend in class assisting the pupils. We start slightly earlier for P1 at 12:05 and then filter year groups across the time. After a few early teething problems, the past few days have gone smoothly



and all have been seated to eat by 12:50-55 at the latest. This gives the pupils approximately 20-25 minutes for those last served to eat their lunch, similar to the time they had last session. Thank you to those who have given feedback and have had any questions about this; we will continue to monitor and adapt things as necessary.

<u>Playground and playfield</u>



We are delighted to add 3 new pieces of playground equipment to our site this week. The equipment was purchased to support and develop play and were chosen by the pupils. A mixture of fundraising and school funding has allowed these to be purchased. These will be opened to pupils today. It is important we look after the equipment so that it is able to be used for years to come.

Learning Journals

Following the successful introduction last session, we are continuing our use of Learning

Journals this year. This is an online Parent/School Communication app that allows school to easily share examples of your pupil's work; it will play an important role in improving our regular reporting of pupil's work to parents. Each term, the aim will be to post examples of work in literacy, maths, health and other areas of the curriculum. Parents should receive email notifications on when new posts are



uploaded and the easiest way to access them is via the Learning Journals app. Their <u>website</u> offers further support, this contains a <u>parents guide</u> and easy-to-follow <u>video</u> <u>guides</u>. If you have any further problems accessing your child's journal or require your email address to be up-dated, please contact the school.

<u>Google Classroom</u>

Similar to last session, each class or stage created a virtual classroom link that was their one stop base for information on timetabling, home learning tasks and termly curricular focus. The aim is to have these live and distributed by early next week.

<u> Parent Volunteers - We need You!</u>

Following cutbacks to support across the authority, we have a recruitment drive ongoing for any parental volunteers to assist us in school. This might be an hour at



lunchtimes, a morning or afternoon to assist in our library; our aim to prioritise PSA support in class or supporting those pupils that really need it. In order to do this, we need adult assistance in other areas of the school at specific times. There is a PVG and paperwork check process to go through for any volunteer in school but once completed, will last the duration of your time as a volunteer. Even if you aren't available this term but may be later

in the session, please contact us and we will start the process. Anyone interested in volunteering in school can complete the <u>form</u> or contact the school directly. Thank you to those that have already completed the paperwork, we hope to get the necessary clearance through very soon.

<u>Achievements.</u>

Last session we had many, many examples of fantastic pupil achievements. These were

shared on our Achievement Wall and on our school Facebook Page. We have archived these achievements into an Achievements book for everyone to look through in the school library.


