Mobile Devices Policy and Acceptable Use Policy Update

As a part of our policy reviews we have made significant changes to our Mobile

Devices Policy. The rapid expansion and upgrading of mobile devices and technologies presents both opportunities and challenges for school, particularly over the developments of digital wearable devices. As a school, we have long taken the stance that pupils do not require access to mobile phones when on our campus both in term of safeguarding the pupils and



keeping the devices safe. Wearables present a greater challenge and while many offer similar functionality to mobile phones; others can be limited and their functionality controlled by parents. As result, our stance, is if any of these devices are used in ways that infringe upon the <u>Acceptable Use Policy</u> and/or the Mobile Device policy; sanctions will be put in place that may or may not involve contacting parents and/or the police.

The Policies can be viewed on the links provided and we welcome any thoughts or comments on these whilst they remain at the draft stage. They will remain in consultation until the 25th September 2023.
