Our janitor's remit is to clear a path from the school car park to the main school entrance and, where possible, the many fire exits that surround our building. He often goes way beyond this remit but does not have the capacity to clear pathways leading

to and from the school. Our priority remains to keep the school open for all of our pupils and staff; if our community can help with this, working together to grit pavements and walkways to and from school, this would be to everyone's benefit.
