<u>Parent Engagement – reports feedback</u>

Results from our recent parent engagement survey are as follows, thank you to everyone that took the time to complete it:

72% of responses found the new reporting format very helpful 20% somewhat helpful 8% others

Next steps: clarify the levels, what these mean and how pupils achieve them. Make pupils next steps clearer.

90% of pupil's learning journals are updated on at least a termly basis, this is in line with our policy and practice on utilising the online journals.

Next steps: still some inconsistences across classes/stages on the regularity of posts that school will continue to work hard to eliminate.

92% of parents completing the form have found the open afternoons helpful in reporting pupil progress. As well as providing opportunities to see your child's classroom and work.

Next steps: we understand this puts pressure on working parents and the impact this may have on pupils whose parents don't attend these events. With the vast majority finding these events helpful and the turnout remaining high, we will endeavour to calanderise future events as far in advance as possible.

Finally; 58% of responses believed we report children's progress very effectively with parents, 36% effectively and 6% somewhat effectively.

School will continue to maintain it's approaches used to report to parents and look to implement the next steps as detailed above.
