Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to announce that we are able to offer swimming lessons at Inverurie Swimming Pool again this session. Our Parent Forum have kindly agreed to part fund a bus that will transport the pupils to and from the pool each Friday. We are asking for a one-off payment of £5 per pupil to cover the rest of the costs. Similar to last year, we have a slot booked from 2-3pm on a Friday and Mrs Fowler, along with two other trained coaches, will offer a differentiated programme of swimming lessons for a period of up to 5 weeks. This will vary from assisting children who have never swum before to developing those who are more confident in the water.

It is important that on Friday your child brings:

- A swimming costume and towel
- Cap and goggles, if they wish

All floats, armbands and other training aids will be supplied by the swimming pool so there is no need for your child to bring any of these. We need parental volunteers to assist us each Friday, if you are free to help please tick the box below.

The swimming will begin on Friday 24th January and we need your consent before your child can take part in the lessons.
