Dear Parents and Carers,

Please find the parent consent form and medical details forms attached to this letter. It is very important that we receive the correct, updated information for your child before they commence on this trip. All information that you provide will be treated in confidence and will be shared with only those members of staff who need to be aware of it. Our aim is to provide a positive, enjoyable experience of a residential school trip so we require all the information we can to ensure that this happens. If your child is taking, or needs to carry, any form of medication (including prescription creams, any form of painkiller, inhalers, Antihistamines etc..) then a further form needs to be completed either to allow staff, or the pupil themselves, to administer the medication. Please see the school office for a copy of a medication form. **All forms to be returned to class teachers by Wednesday 26th February.**

Also included is a kit list which has been modified from the recommended list of a 4 night activity break provide by SU Scotland. The key is to pack warm, waterproof clothing as the pupils will be outside for all activities. It is also a good idea to pack with your child so they know what belongs to them and name all items! All bedding is provided by SU Scotland.

Finally, we have included a behavioural agreement which needs to be signed by each child. This has been discussed with the pupils in school. This is to clarify the behavioural expectations for each pupil on this trip to provide each of them a safe, enjoyable experience.

Kit List

It is important that you are able to stay warm and dry.

Clothes

- 3 pairs of trousers (denim jeans are not suitable)
- 3 long sleeved tops
- 4 pairs of socks
- 3 sets of underwear
- warm nightwear

Outer Clothing

- waterproof jacket (ideally with a hood)

- hat and gloves

Personal Effects

- wash kit
